RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, over forty enrolled members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe from the communities of Whiteriver, Canyon Day and McNary have petitioned the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council seeking authority for the use of land claims funds for the purpose of repairing and improving the lighting at the Old Fair Grounds; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to meet the needs of the local communities and to be responsive to their needs.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the land claims funds are authorized to be used for the purpose of repairing and improving the lighting at the Old Fair Grounds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Herbert Tate, Council Delegate from District IV, is authorized to seek bids for this project and to work with appropriate tribal offices to accomplish this purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
