RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 04-88-101 the Tribal Council authorized the establishment of a White Mountain Apache Labor Relations Commission Hearing Board; and
- WHEREAS, at the present time there is a need to name a person as an alternate for the Board; and
- WHEREAS, the Director of the Labor Relations has recommended that Cheryl Ricker be named as an alternate; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has determined that Cheryl Ricker should be named as an alternate to the Board.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Ms. Cheryl Ricker to serve as an alternate on the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Labor Relations Commission Hearing Board effective immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on June 16, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
