RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a policy for firearms use is needed on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Game and Fish Department has developed a written firearms policy that meets the needs of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and support for such a policy is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approves of and supports the firearms policy developed by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Game and Fish Department.

The foregoing resolution was on June 22, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
