RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that 25 CFR Part 163, General Forest Regulations, requires consent of Indian owners for harvesting miscellaneous forest products under timber cutting permits; and
- WHEREAS, 53 BIAM 4.3.B. also requires the preparation of the annual or other periodic Timber Use Policy Statements by the Superintendent; and
- WHEREAS, this statement will specify minimum stumpage rates, species and types of miscellaneous forest products to be harvested, and provide information to be used as guidelines in issuing timber cutting permits.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Timber Use Rules and Instructions attached hereto are approved for Fiscal Years 1988 and 1989.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in order to expedite the issuance of the permits, the Fort Apache Agency Forest Manager is designated to act for the Tribal Chairman as Issuing Officer, and who also will be the Superintendent's delegated representative as Approving Officer.

The foregoing resolution was on June 22, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
