RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- the Tribal Council is advised that Arnold Pailzote, WHEREAS, Jr., is an enrolled member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe whose name was inadvertently omitted from the per capita settlement, Claims Case 22-D; and
- an incorrect birthdate entry resulted in Mr. Pail-WHEREAS, zote's name omission and resulted in non-receipt by Arnold Pailzote of his per capita distribution prior to the close out of the 22-D Claims Account.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that authorization is given to utilize tribal funds for payment to Arnold Pailzote Jr. for his per capita share of the 22-D land claims settlement with the understanding that such funds will be reimbursed to the tribal funds from 22-D funds transferred to the White Mountain Apache tribe by Resolution No. 05-88-146.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 05-88-141 is amended in part so as to accomplish the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 16, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
