RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- Council Secretary, pursuant to Tribal WHEREAS, the Tribal Ordinance Number 59, recommends to the Tribal Council that the individuals listed on the attached list who have applied for membership into the White Mountain Apache Tribe be accepted as members; and
- the Council Secretary advises that each person listed WHEREAS, on the attached list qualifies for membership and recommends that their membership status be approved and that they be adopted as members of the Tribe even though their parents or legal guardians did not file an enrollment application within one year of the date of their birth; and
- the Tribal Council has reviewed the applicant list and WHEREAS, concurs with the Secretary's recommendation that the persons listed be granted membership status.

The foregoing resolution was on July 6, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
