RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has allotments of houses, Projects AZ 16-43 and AZ 16-44, to be built by HUD on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to express its concern that three units of the housing under consideration be made particularly available and equipped for the handicapped or the elderly; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to designate areas for housing for the handicapped and elderly.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates the communities of East Fork, Seven Mile and one house at Canyon Day to be sites for housing for the handicapped or the elderly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Lafe Altaha is designated to work with the Housing Authority Director to assure that this special housing becomes a reality.

The foregoing resolution was on November 9, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
