RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Community has obtained funding for and is in the process of constructing a playground to be located near the old Cedar Creek Trading Post; and

WHEREAS, the community is in need of a fence to be utilized in the construction of said playground; and

WHEREAS, the chainlink fence and posts located south of the Apache Enterprise Warehouse, formerly the dog pound, are currently not in use; and

WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Community is requesting that the Tribal Council authorize the removal of the chain link fence and posts for its use in the construction of the Cedar Creek Community playground; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the removal of the chain link fence and posts located south of the Apache Enterprise Warehouse, for use by the Cedar Creek Community for the purpose of constructing their community playground.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ONE</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
