## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised the homesite lease held by Howard and Marsha Peddie expired December 31, 1988; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Howard Peddie have reassigned their home to tribal member Andrita (Bennett) Jefferson; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Andrita (Bennett) Jefferson wishes to take over ownership of the home formerly occupied by the Peddie's.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval of the voluntary transaction of Mr. and Mrs. Howard Peddie in reassigning their home to Mr. and Mrs. William Jefferson, and grants the Jeffersons a homesite on the land area.

The foregoing resolution was on January 11, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
