RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Mr. Gregory Dean Kinney, whose birthdate is July 29, 1946, has requested enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe since June 23, 1965; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Mr. Kinney's request and supporting documents; and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee finds that Mr. Kinney is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and possesses the necessary blood quantum of one-half White Mountain Apache through his father, Mr. Howard D. Kinney; and
- WHEREAS, Gregory Dean Kinney has been a permanent resident of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation since 1970; and
- WHEREAS, Gregory Dean Kinney is willing to and shall provide to the Tribal Council Secretary, proof of his relinquishment of his enrollment in the Navajo Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, although Mr. Kinney has never received per capita payments from the Navajo Tribe, he is willing to waive receipt of any anticipated payment from Docket 22-H with the White Mountain Apache Tribe should a settlement be made.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee, the enrollment of Gregory Dean Kinney is granted, contingent upon Mr. Kinney executing a waiver of payment of any proceeds arising out of any final settlement of the Tribe's pending claim before the United States Claims Court in Docket 22-H.

The foregoing resolution was on January 11, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958,
