RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Ms. Patsy (Kasey) Zahgotah, whose birthdate is January 4, 1950, has requested enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe since 1974; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Ms. Zahgotah's request and supporting documents; and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee finds that Ms. Zahgotah is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and possesses the necessary blood quantum of one-half White Mountain Apache through her father, Mr. Lester Kasey; and
- WHEREAS, Patsy (Kasey) Zahgotah has been a permanent resident of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation since 1977; and
- WHEREAS, Patsy (Kasey) Zahgotah is willing to and shall provide to the Tribal Council Secretary, proof of her relinquishment of her enrollment in the San Carlos Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Zahgotah has received her share of per capita payment from San Carlos Apache Tribe's Docket 22-H; and
- WHEREAS, although Ms. Zahgotah did not receive a share of per capita payment from Land Claims Docket 22-D due to not being enrolled at White Mountain Apache nor the San Carlos Apache Tribe, she is willing to waive receipt of any anticipated payment from Docket 22-H with the White Mountain Apache Tribe should a settlement be made.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee, the enrollment of Patsy (Kasey) Zahgotah is granted, contingent upon Ms. Zahgotah executing a waiver of payment of any proceeds arising out of any final settlement of the Tribe's pending claim before the United States Claims Court in Docket 22-H.
