RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by Beverly A. Stago, Housing IMprovement Program Coordinator, that under FY-87 H.I.P. Contract, monies are still available; and
- WHEREAS, these funds can be used to build two (2) additional homes under this contract; and
- WHEREAS, it has been proposed by H.I.P. Coordinator that Omar Aday from District III and Harold Thomas from District IV to be added to the qualifying applicants to utilize such monies to build two (2) additional houses under this contract.
- BE IT RESOLVE by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Omar Aday and Mr. Harold Thomas are hereby added to the qualifying applicants to receive assistance for new homes under the Housing Improvement Program. Construction is to start as soon as Land Assignments have been approved by the Tribal Land Board.

The foregoing resolution was on January 13, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
