## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Sylvia Endfield has requested that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe give her the house formerly occupied by Johnny Lee adjacent to the Trading Post; and
- WHEREAS, the lease for the land has expired and said land area has both a house and a trading post plus other buildings situated on it; and
- WHEREAS, at the expiration of the lease the land and buildings reverted to the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby gives the house referred to above to Sylvia Endfield on an "as is" basis and with the explicit statement and understanding given to Ms. Endfield that in giving her the house the White Mountain Apache Tribe assumes no liability whatsoever.
- FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that Sylvia Endfield may have this house on the condition that she go before the Land Board and make application for and receive a homesite lease for the land on which the house is situated; and
- FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe reserves the right to determine the boundaries of said homesite lease area.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 2, 1989</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>Eight for and Zero against</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.-984)
