on said date, March 31, 1989, the White Mountain WHEREAS, Apache Tribe will host a luncheon for fifty to onehundred participants;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it authorizes the slaughter of an elk from the elk population and a beef from the Tribal Herd for the Barbeque scheduled for 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 use at p.m. on March 31, 1989, to provide lunch to the visiting the White Mountain Apache participants reservation from the 13th Annual National Indian Timber Symposium.

The foregoing resolution was on  $\underline{\text{March 2, 1989,}}$  duly adopted by a vote of  $\underline{\text{Six for and One Against}}$  by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
