RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilman Herbert Tate has brought to the attention of the Tribal council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the need for a safer location for the gasoline storage tanks providing fuel to the reservation communities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desire to move the location to a safer place such that said tanks will be removed from housing areas.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Councilman Tate and the Safety Committee with other appropriate persons/officials to recommend a new location for said tanks; a site in the industrial complex should be considered.

The foregoing resolution was on March 2, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of Eight for and Zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
