## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has received all the documents related to the Grievance Appeal of Claudine L. Goklish, Appeal No. 88-02, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered these documents and has heard on several occassions from Gerald Alsenay, the Manager, and Claudine L. Goklish, the appellant, and Gertie Lupe and others on both sides of the issues; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has considered all the evidence;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the recommendations of the Grievance Committee to reinstate Claudine L. Goklish to the position of Manager at the Hon Dah Station/Motel and be paid in full the back pay from the time she was terminated is overturned.

The foregoing resolution was on March 01, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIVE</u> for and <u>FOUR</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
