- WHEREAS, Mrs. Priscilla Seymour, grandmother of Amy Seymour, has requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Amy Seymour during the weekend of September 2, 3 & 4, 1989, during the Tribal Fair weekend; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Rupert Thompson have been chosen as Godparents and Rupert & Agnes (Bush) Thompson have accepted the role; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mrs. Seymour Sponsor, and Mr. & Mrs. Rupert Thompson, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Amy Seymour during the weekend of September 2, 3, & 4, 1989, at the old fairgrounds.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
