- WHEREAS, the housing area and houses need attention and proper administration; and
- Matthew Hinton has worked for the Tribe in McNary WHEREAS, for the McNary Administration for four years in various jobs and is presently acting manager pending a permanent hiring; and
- WHEREAS, restructuring of program is needed and an internal promotion is justified; and
- the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache WHEREAS, Tribe believes that Matthew Hinton is available and capable of managing the McNary housing administration.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain. Apache Tribe that Matthew Hinton is hereby hired as manager for McNary Administration.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
