## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council Secretary, pursuant to Tribal Ordinance No. 59, recommends to the Tribal Council that the individuals listed on the attached list who have applied for membership into the White Mountain Apache Tribe be accepted as members; and
- WHEREAS, the Council secretary advises that each person listed on the attached list qualifies for membership and recommends that their membership status be approved and that they be adopted as members of the Tribe even though their parents or legal guardians did not file an enrollment application within one year of the date of their birth; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the applicant list and concurs with the Secretary's recommendation that the persons listed be granted membership status.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the seventy-seven (77) applicants on the attached list are hereby enrolled into the membership of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 24, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
