RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has funds under the BIA's banded budget referred to as the community fire protection account; and
- WHEREAS, the BIA Fire Department is geared only to protect the buildings and property belonging to the BIA; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to contract the community fire protection program from the BIA;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requests contracting of the community fire protection program in FY 89; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, or his representative is authorized to enter into, negotiate, and execute a P.L. 93-638 community fire protection contract in FY 89; and
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the program contract term shall be from May 1, 1989 through April 30, 1992 and the Tribe will apply for a three-year contract beginning May 1, 1989.

The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
