RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 2.6 of the White Mountain Apache Game and Fish Code, the White Mountain Apache Game and Fish Department has the authority, subject to approval of the tribal council to open, close or alter seasons and to establish bag and possession limits for wildlife; and
- WHEREAS, after reviewing the previous years' hunting regulations and analyzing collected biological data, the Department has developed recommendations for the 1989 non-tribal hunting seasons; and
- WHEREAS, the Department has proposed a "special, non-tribal affiliated cow hunt" which will assist in achieving current elk management objectives for the reservation and;
- WHEREAS, fee increases have been proposed for trophy elk, bear, lion and small game hunting.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has reviewed and considered the proposed 1989 non-tribal hunting regulations; and hereby approves the regulations as amended by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on June 8, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of <u>FIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
