RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- by Resolution No. 81-223, the White Mountain WHEREAS, Apache Tribal Council set aside the Hurricane Timber sale area for the exclusive use of wildlife and deferred logging from the unit; and
- the unit is now a very important wildlife manage-WHEREAS, ment area for big game, including deer, turkey, elk, bear and lion and the Apache Trout; and
- WHEREAS, the Resolution No. 81-223 setting aside the area for the purpose of wildlife management expired.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe designates the Hurricane Logging Unit a wildlife area and that all logging be deferred in this unit for four years.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ONE</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
