RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, contract employee, Hayden Anderson of the Fort Apache Timber Company, addressed the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe seeking approval from the Tribal Council for his contract to include tribal fringe benefits; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe generally does not include tribal fringe benefits as part of the agreement with contract employees; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is in agreement that Mr. Hayden Anderson that despite the fact that he is a contract employee may still receive tribal fringe benefits.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby approves a modification to Mr. Hayden Anderson's contract allowing Mr. Anderson to receive tribal fringe benefits.
- FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that financial services and FATCO management is hereby directed to take appropriate actions to modify Mr. Anderson's contract to implement this Tribal Council action.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 12, 1989</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
