RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is operating under an expired Loan Agreement with the First Interstate Bank of Arizona, which agreement provides an unsecured Line of Credit n the amount of \$1,100,000 (one million one hundred thousand dollars) for the Sunrise Ski Area; and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to continue these same credit arrangements with the First Interstate Bank.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman, or in his absence the Vice Chairman, the Tribal Controller, and the Tribal Treasurer are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to renew said Line of Credit with First Interstate Bank of Arizona and are hereby delegated authority to negotiate said line of credit for \$1,100,000;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe does hereby agree to pay such rate of interest as may be agreed upon by the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence, the Vice Chairman, and the Tribal Treasurer and Tribal Controller; not to exceed any lawful established rate on said borrowing and does hereby authorize the execution, in the name of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, of the appropriate and necessary documents and does agree to pay interest at such agreed upon rate.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each of the above individuals are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to execute in the name of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, any and all documents necessary to execute document for said line of credit said under the terms and condition agreed upon.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it

by Article V, Section 1 (a) (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
