RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Henry Kessay, Jr., has applied for a tribal loan to construct a new home; and
- WHEREAS, a homesite lease is required by Section 21 (3) 2 of the Declaration of Policies and Plan of Operation approved July 22, 1975 in order to construct a home; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe supports such loan acquisition and homesite provided the leasehold improvements are mortgaged to the White Mountain Apache Tribal Revolving Credit Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and grants a homesite lease to Henry Kessay, Jr., for a period of twenty-five (25) years with an option for an additional term of twenty-five (25) years at a rate of \$1.00 for twenty-five (25) years, payable in advance on the first day of the month following the effective date of the lease; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman shall execute said lease for and on the behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in accordance with Tribal Ordinance No. 44; the effective date of the commencement of said homesite lease being the date of the approval of the loan by the Secretary of the Interior or his designated representative; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman shall approve a term in the leasehold mortgage mortgaging the improvements to the White Mountain Apache Tribal Revolving Credit Program; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the loan not be approved within one hundred eighty (180) days from the date hereof, the lease and approval of rights to mortgage the leasehold improvements shall thereby automatically terminate.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
