RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the business lease for the Whiteriver Trading Company in the Whiteriver Community has now expired and the property has reverted to tribal ownership; and
- WHEREAS, the site improvements such as buildings and other structures on the lease site must be removed and cleaned-up; and
- WHEREAS, all of the utilities servicing the site have been disconnected; and
- WHEREAS, the old Whiteriver Trading Company store building has no salvage value and should be demolished and hauled out to the dump yard as soon as possible with the other structures at the site to follow as soon as possible; and
- WHEREAS, FATCO has certain heavy equipment which can be utilized in the demolition.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. Milfred Cosen, General Manager of the Fort Apache Timber Company is directed to assist with the demolition by utilizing FATCO's equipment and operators in the above demolition and clean-up project; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Milfred Cosen, General Manager, is directed to meet with the community service personnel to plan, coordinate and accomplish the above project as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (h), & (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
