- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Whiteriver.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Van and Charlotte (Quintero) Bahlen, Sponsors, and Melvin and Imogene Elago as Godparents to hold a Ceremonial Sunrise Dance on August 26, 1989, at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on August 3, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
