RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Justin Williams has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe his desire to renovate and restore irrigation works to his seven acre farmland; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believe it to be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that as much farmland as possible be put to use by irrigation.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby request that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Land Operations Department assist Mr. Justin Williams with equipment and manpower for the purpose of renovating the irrigation ditches, turnouts, irrigation works for the purpose of restoring irrigation to Mr. Justin Williams seven acre farmland.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority bested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a,f) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
