RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need for construction of new roads and streets to serve the residents of the communities within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need for route surveys, environmental studies, archaelogical and soils investigations, material prospecting, coordination with utility companies, the Tribal Land Office and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority prior to construction of needed roads and streets; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need to complete certain preliminary survey work well in advance of proposed construction schedules; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need to complete surveys at least four (4) years prior to actual construction so that as excess road construction funds become available, projects can be built on short notice if such plans for new streets are available and complete.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby grants the Bureau of Indian Affairs permission to perform route surveys, environmental studies, archaeological and soils investigations, material prospecting for needed streets and roads within and adjacent to the communities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Bureau's permission to carry out this preliminary work shall be contingent upon the submission to the Tribal Council of a plan showing the projects which are being preliminarily studied and a projection of possible construction start dates.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 13, 1989</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>Nine</u> for and <u>Zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) and (g) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.-984).
