## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is responsible for the health and safety of the public using public facilities on the White Mountain Apache Reservation; and

the sliding door at the White Mountain Supermarket WHEREAS, is in need of repair so that it will be safe for the publics use; and

WHEREAS, the supermarket budget for 1989/90 will need to be adjusted in this regard.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorized the manager of the White Mountain Supermarket to immediately fix the unsafe sliding door at the White Mountain Apache Supermarket and appropriate steps taken to amend the supermarket budget in this regard.

The foregoing resolution was on September 19, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 5 (h,i,k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
