- WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Audie Skidmore have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mr. and Mrs. Gibson and Gloria Pinal and Audie and Nancy Skidmore, Godparents to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of June 15, 16, and 17, 1990, at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on September 19, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f), (g), and (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
