RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Roberta Leslie, a tribal members has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the termination and lay-off from employment 29 employees of the Bureau of Indian Affairs forestry department without due process; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe fears that some retaliation against Ms. Leslie may occur within the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby fully supports Ms. Leslie's actions to report employee complaints; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Bureau of Indian Affair Superintendent, Area Director, their designees, employees, and agents be hereby directed to refrain from taking any retaliation against Ms. Leslie for her actions in reporting on the terminations to the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on October 11, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a & c) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
