## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and has authority to authorize all proposals to be submitted on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe working with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Office of Indian Education requests support from the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council in their request for funds provided under P.L. 99-457 to be utilized pursuant to a 638 Contract with the BIA/OIEP office for Head Start; and
- WHEREAS, there is a need at the White Mountain Apache Head Start to hire more individuals to work with preschool children and the White Mountain Apache Head Start is requesting funds in the amount of up to \$62,917.00.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Chairman or
  his designee is hereby authorized to review and approve
  the proposal for requesting funds provided under P.L.
  99-457 from the BIA/OIEP for use by the White Mountain
  Apache Head Start Program pursuant to a 638 contract.

The foregoing resolution was on October 11, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a, b and c) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
