RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed by the Director of the White Mountain Apache Head Start of the need to add an additional classroom to the Cibecue Head Start in order to accommodate the growing needs of our children;
- WHEREAS, the Head Start Director with his staff has prepared an inventory of the supplies, manpower and support necessary to secure an additional classroom; and
- WHEREAS, it has been determined that Twenty-Thousand Dollars-(\$20,000) is required to proceed with opening an additional Head Start Classroom at Cibecue; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is in agreement that the White Mountain Apache Head Start should be expanded to accommodate our children and provide them with their educational needs; and
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the release of Twenty--Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) from its amended tribal budget for the purpose of proceeding with hiring of staff and obtaining materials for an additional Head Start classroom at Cibecue during FY89/90.

The foregoing resolution was on October 11, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat.-984).
