RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Game and Fish resources of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are available to be harvested by all members of the Tribe trough the application process as provided by the Tribal Council through the Game and Fish regulations; and
- WHEREAS, Bowman Beatty, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Family No. 296 of the Dischinn'd Clan has been denied hunting tags on the White Mountain Apache Tribe in 1988 and 1989; and
- WHEREAS, the laws and regulations of the White Mountain Apache Tribe apply equally to the tribal members and the Game and Fish resources are available to all members unless limited by the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council directs the Game and Fish Department to issue hunting tags to Bowman Beatty, a White Mountain Apache Tribal member effective immediately if it appears that all criminal charges have been dismissed.

The foregoing resolution was on October 11, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
