RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Council Member Kino Kane from District II has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council the upcoming Holiday Season and his wish that Land Claim funds be utilized for distributing candy to his community; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has considered the request and believes a consolidated plan for distribution of candy to all communities on the White Mountain Apache reservation is appropriate.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the utilization of Land Claim Funds for Christmas candy distribution to all communities throughout the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on November 02, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
