RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain apache Tribe is advised that 25 CFR Part 163, General Forest Regulations, requires consent of the Indian owners for harvesting miscellaneous forest products under timber cutting permits; and
- WHEREAS, 53 BIAM 4.3.B also requires the preparation of an annual or periodic Timber Use Policy Statement by the Superintendent; and
- WHEREAS, this statement will specify minimum stumpage rates, species and types of miscellaneous forest products to be harvested, information to be used as guidelines in issuing timmber cutting permits, and authority to issue cutting permits.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Timber Use Rules and Instructions attached hereto are approved temporarily with direction to the issuing officer to advise the permittees selling off reservation the true cost and value of the wood, with direction to include provision for firewood cutting for the elderly and the provision of Christmas trees for the elderly.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in order to expedite the issuance of permits, the Fort Apache agency Forest Manager is authorized to sign—the permits issued pursuant to the Miscellaneous Wood Products Rules and Instructions as adopted by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs in cooperation with the tribal Forester is directed to present to the tribal Council within thirty (30) days a proposal addressing the concerns of the Tribal Council with the sale of wood off reservation and further addressing the tribal Council concerning the tribe and its member receive the true and full value of the Tribe's Forest Products.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 10, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote <u>eight for and zero against</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and
