

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Indians have unique and special employment rights on their own reservations; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has the inherent sovereign power to pass laws to implement and enforce those special rights on behalf of the Indians; and

WHEREAS, Indians are also entitled to the protection of the laws that the Federal Government has adopted to eliminate discrimination, and Tribal Governments can and should play a role in the enforcement of those laws; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes it is important to establish a prevailing wage rate on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to obtain more qualified persons to work on construction projects throughout the reservation to increase the quality of work performed; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes a prevailing wage rate on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for construction projects; which wage scale shall be posted at each construction site; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Labor Relations Department is given authority to enforce the prevailing wage rate on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all contractors and subcontractors doing construction work on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation are required to pay their workers on a weekly basis without subsequent deductions or rebate.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (i) of the Amended Constitution and
