

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been informed by Councilman Nozie that the East Fork Community plans an East Fork Community Basketball Tournament; and

WHEREAS, said tournament proceeds will be used by the community for a program of recreational activities for the youth of East Fork such as field trips, movies, etc.; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes it to be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the Tribal Council to support such youth activities because the young people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are the future of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the expenditures of \$1,000.00 from the Land Claim funds to be used by the East Fork Community for an East Fork Community Basketball Tournament to be held February 9-10, 1990.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1, (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
