

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe set the annual allowable cut on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for FY 1989-1990 at 67.7 million board feet; and

WHEREAS, 463 thousand board feet of the above amount was inadvertently brought in just prior to the beginning of this period; and

WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company was not able to purchase sufficient National Forest timber to maintain normal production quotas during this period; and

WHEREAS, an additional 1.953 million board feet was planned for cutting from the West Management Unit in FY 1990-1991 to compensate for undercutting the allowable cut in the past.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the annual allowable cut for FY 1989-1990 be revised by 1.953 million board feet to 69.553 million board feet based on the 1990-1991 plan to cut said amount to compensate for undercutting the allowable cut in the past; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that 1.953 million board feet be deducted from the annual allowable cut that the Tribal Council sets for FY 1990-1991.

The foregoing resolution was on January 31, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


