RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe adopted Resolution No. 09-89-233, which directed that proposed new road alignments be carefully examined and assessed to ensure that economic and environmental impacts be balanced; and
- WHEREAS, the above resolution was passed after approval of the Deer Springs Timber Sale contract, which included road construction plans; and
- WHEREAS, the Forestry Committee Chairman and Tribal Forester have closely examined certain proposed realignments and new road construction proposed on the Deer Springs Timber Sale on which logging is planned for February, 1990.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the roads found necessary for realignment and/or construction on the Deer Springs Timber Sale by the Forestry Committee Chairman and Tribal Forester, as shown on the attached map are approved by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 31, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine for and zero against</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
