

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe obtained a P. L. 93-638 Contract to prepare an Environmental Assessment on the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Forest Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has reviewed the "Environmental Assessment of the Proposed Forest Management activities associated with implementing the 1987 Forest Inventory Analysis on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arizona (EA)"; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that the Environmental Assessment presented to it on January 31, 1990, meets the Tribe's P. L. 93-638 contractual obligations to prepare the Environmental Assessment in full.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Environmental Assessment of the BIA Proposed Forest Management on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation be submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs in fulfillment of the White Mountain Apache Tribe's contractual obligations under the P. L. 93-638 Contract.

The foregoing resolution was on January 31, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (b) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


