


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Darlene (Clarkson) Burnette has come before the Tribal Council to advise that her son Colbert Burnette has been contacted by International Sports Tours to invite him to participate as a U.S.A. athlete on a twenty-three (23) day tour of Finland and the U.S.S.R.; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes it is in the best interest of it's young people to participate in such broadening experiences and has on other occasions assisted other young people in this type of endeavor;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) from the General Land Claim Funds be contributed to Colbert Burnette to enable him to participate in the International Sports Tours Glasnost 1990 Tour.

The foregoing resolution was on February 21, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
