RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to recontract for Fy90/91 for the Higher Education Grant, Johnson O'Malley Supplemental Funds, Adult Vocational Training Grant, and the Adult Education Grant of the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the P.L. 93-638 Education Program contracts have, in the past, been successfully administered by the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Education Director is to run concurrent with the term of the Contract from May 1, 1990 to April 30, 1991.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Education Director is hereby authorized to plan, develop, negotiate and administer the Grants and Education Funds and Contracts discussed herein.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and/or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman are authorized and directed to sign the negotiated Educational Contracts for the FY 90/91 for the following programs: (1) Higher Education; (2) Johnson O'Malley Program; (3) Adult Vocational Training; (4) Adult Education (GED).

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (b) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
