## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Vice Chairman Alvino Hawkins has been invited to attend a conference in Charlotte, South Carolina in April, 1990; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to have tribal representation at said conference;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that two tribal representatives of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe including the Vice Chairman attend the conference in Charlotte, South Carolina and their expenses be paid by the Tribe from the litigation funds.

The foregoing resolution was on February 22, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
