RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Bureau of Indian Affairs intends to detail Bobby Thompson, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Superintendent for Education to Sacaton for 120 days; and
- WHEREAS, the detailing of Bureau of Indian Affairs employees away from Whiteriver serves only the Bureau of Indian Affairs interests and works to the detriment of the White Mountain Apache Tribe;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it opposes the detail of Bobby Thompson, Bureau of Indian Affairs Superintendent for Education to Sacaton for the reason that it is not in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 22, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
