

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Veda Cota a tribal member has come before the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to discuss her grievance appeal; and

WHEREAS, her request is that all references in her personnel file related to insubordination be deleted; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Cota is not requesting that she be reinstated or that she be given back pay as recommended by the Grievance Committee;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all reference in Veda Cota's personnel file for insubordination to be deleted and that the Form E showing her termination reflect a resignation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Personnel Department is hereby directed to take the actions necessary to carry out this resolution.


The foregoing resolution was on March 14, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
