RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Jennie (Baha) Palmer, a tribal member has requested assistance be given her daughter, Deborah Sue Alchesay-Baha, in acquiring a H.I.P. house; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and it's members that adequate housing be made available for each household;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a letter be written to the Director of the H.I.P. Program requesting that Deborah Sue Alchesay-Baha be considered for a H.I.P. house and that personnel from the Program assist Deborah Sue Alchesay-Baha in completing the application and other necessary paperwork.

The foregoing resolution was on March 14, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
