

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the General Election of the White Mountain Apache Tribe will be held on April 4, 1990; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission has advised the Tribal Council that the cost of the primary election of the tribe held on February 7, 1990 was somewhat higher than had been anticipated due to the poor conditions at several of the polling site buildings; and
- WHEREAS, the Election Commission is of the opinion that the polling sites should be repaired prior to the General Election on April 4, 1990; and
- WHEREAS, the Election Commission has determined it to be necessary to appoint additional marshalls at most of the polling sites at additional cost; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission is requesting that the Tribal Council modify the 1989/1990 budget to meet the increased cost in planning and staging the 1990 Tribal Elections and the Election Commission is asking that the budget be modified in the amount of \$5,000.00 to cover all anticipated expenses of repairing the election polling sites, appointing additional polling site marshalls and other expenses of staging the election; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the request of the Election Commission is reasonable and necessary.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby modifies the Fiscal Year 1989/1990 budget of the White Mountain Apache Election Commission to reflect a modification of the Election Commission budget by \$5,000.00. The Tribal Controller is hereby directed to implement the increase and to take all necessary measures to carry out the intent and purpose of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 14, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k), (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
