- WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and it's members that useable buildings such as these be turned over to the Tribe rather than demolished;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby joins in the request of the
 Chairman to the Bureau of Indian Affairs that the five
 trailers located at Cibecue scheduled for demolition be
 turned over to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for
 their use;

The foregoing resolution was on March 22, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (c), (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958. pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
